We will travel via bus.

What does the chaperone/leader situation look like?

Our goal is to provide one chaperone for every eight students. Most of our chaperones are your students' weekend small group leaders, but we also enjoy having parents and other adults there as well. If you are interested, we would love to talk more about it with you. Chaperones are with students throughout the day during worship, meals, small group time, and activities. Every chaperone is background checked and trained prior to camp.

What about lodging?

Students will be staying in college dormitories. Most rooms are double occupancy and have two beds, two desks, two chairs, and two dressers. (There are a few one and three person rooms on campus that we use.) Bathrooms vary based on each dorm. (Some rooms have private baths, some share with the room next to it, and some have hallway baths shared by all.) You will need to bring your own linens to fit a twin size bed.

Must I pay the registration fee in full at registration?

Individual registrations must be paid in full at the time of registration. Only families with multiple students will have the option to make a partial payment (50% payment of the total balance) when

registering. The remaining balance will be due June 15th. Any unpaid balance by this time may affect their child's attendance to camp.
